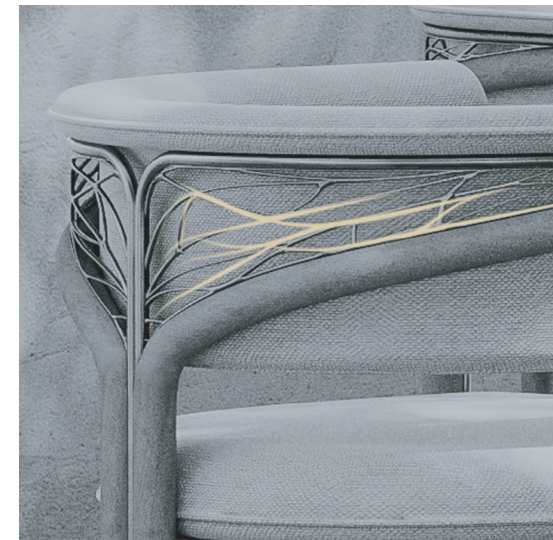
Morpho, an ethereal wonder



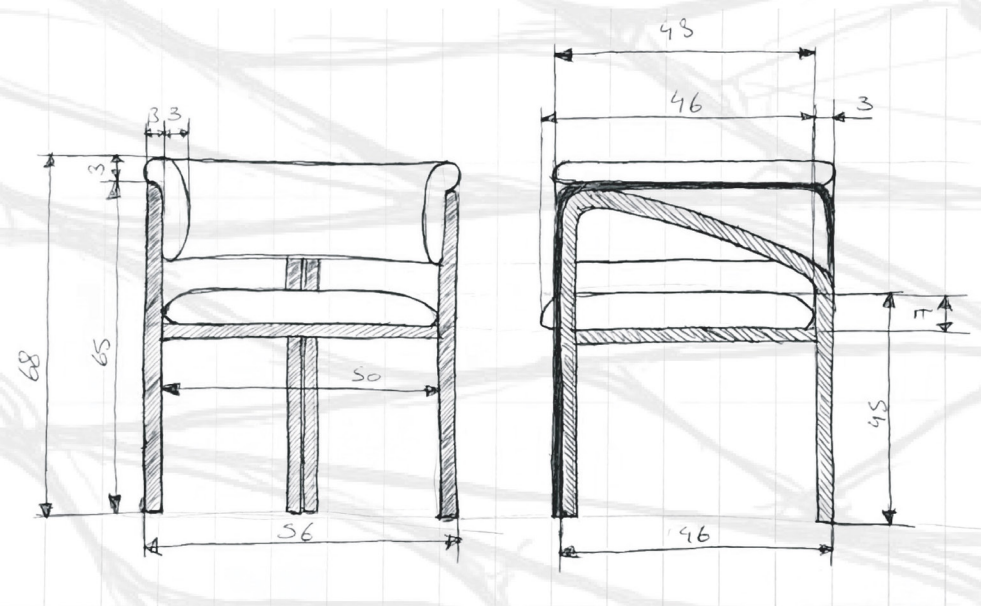

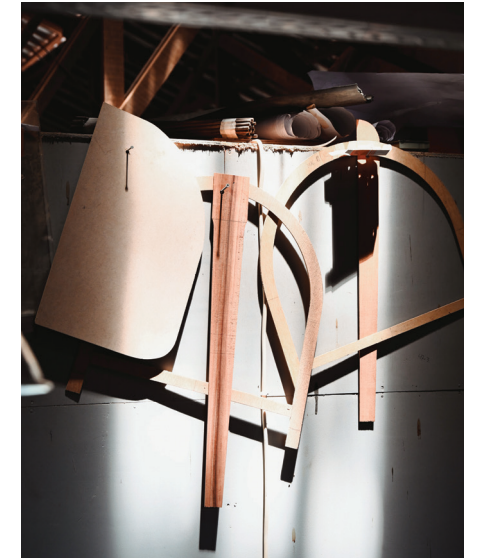
Blend & Combine

For MORPHO's first collection, the iconic dragonfly has served as the main source of inspiration. In the signature dining chair, we see the pattern of the fantastical creature's wings reflected in the delicate metal detailing.

The organic shapes of roots and branches of trees, their twists and turns provided the main source of inspiration for the collection's dining table. The tabletop takes inspiration from Voronoi patterns, which are found all around nature—from giraffe's coats to honeycombs.

Options include natural oak or dark brown teak frame and a wooden, beige or green natural stone top.

Aleta, meaning “little wing,” mirrors the shape of a dragonfly’s wings, offering a subtle nod to this delicate creature.

Indoor options include varnished dark brown teak or natural oak, green velvet, black leather, or beige chenille, and brass-, or bronze-coloured metal accents.

Outdoor options include natural and black-tainted teak, brass-, or bronze-coloured metal accents and four outdoor fabrics.
